CLASSIFICATION OF THE EUROAIRNET STATIONS**

ABSTRACT

The European topic Centre on Air Quality (ETC-AQ), develops and maintains the European Air Quality Monitoring Network (EUROAIRNET) consisting of a selection of monitoring stations from networks, operating in the European countries today. Since various degrees of QA/QC plan completeness, are encountered, a classification scheme based upon QA/QC procedures has been proposed, and a set of minimum QA/QC acceptance requirements to EUROAIRNET has been drafted.
