ABSTRACT

A search has been conducted through the undergraduate and graduate curricula of environmental engineering/science, civil engineering, chemical engineering, and other related departments in universities in the USA, Europe, and other countries of the world, regarding teaching of courses in the area of public and occupational health and safety. Based on this collected and analyzed information, new undergraduate level courses were designed and have been introduced in the curriculum of a newly formed department. Here development, application and evaluation of such courses are described, class material and student projects are outlined, and methods of instruction are presented.
